FREE VIN ETCHING

The Lehigh County District Attorney's Auto Theft and Insurance Fraud Task Force and Whitehall Township Police will conduct VIN Identification Number (VIN) etching. Task Force members will engrave a vehicle's VIN on all windows and the sunroof. The etching is FREE and takes about 5 minutes but can save vehicle owners time, money and aggravation by deterring thieves from targeting etched cars, trucks and sport utility vehicles.
