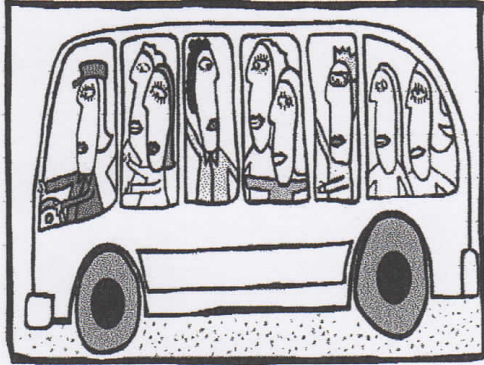


Thomas Iron Works Historic Preservation

On Saturday October 27th, 2018 the Thomas Iron Works Preservation Group will sponsor a guided tour of the neighborhood highlighting the historic significance of the community surrounding the former iron works. Participants will be provided with historical background information, as well as an overview of the planned historic preservation district. The guided tour will travel through the neighborhood pointing out the many sites that were significant to the development of the Iron Works residence as well as the architecture that is still visible today. Some of the sites dating back to when the iron works were in operation we will visit include the First Presbyterian Church, school, Superintendent's home, site of the original train station, the company store and much more.
