SNOUT

Stormwater SNOUTs are specially designed to catch plastics, oil, and sediment from stormwater before it exits the system.

The Snouts have been placed at the last inlet of the storm system before the storm water goes to a basin or leaves the site in new developments.

Recently 6 tons of sediment was removed and disposed of properly from the 3 snouts including all types of floating debris such as Easter eggs, plastic and foam balls and water bottles.
